What happens if you install solar panels without planning permission?

If you install solar panels without the necessary planning permission or in breach of regulations, you could face several legal and financial consequences, including the removal of your panels, fines, legal action, compromised insurance policies, and personal risks such as to your safety and diminished property value.

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels?

However, make sure you follow all building regulations and apply for planning permission if necessary, as your neighbour could report your installation to the local authority if you don't - which could result in your panels having to come down.

Are solar panels a legal requirement for new homes?

Even though installing solar panels on new builds is a great way to set new homes up with renewable energy from day one, it's not yet a legal requirement. One common problem is that developers don't use all the available roof space, resulting in a less effective solar panel system.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Can you put solar panels on a building?

Yes, if the installation falls under permitted development. However, if you live in a conservation area or world heritage site you can't put solar panels on the principal or side elevation walls of your house if it fronts a highway. Are solar panels mandatory on new builds in the UK?

Solar panels aren't mandatory on new builds in the UK. However, other parts of the world have implemented requirements - in the EU, for example, solar panels will be mandatory on all new residential buildings by 2030.
