

Can a refurbished phone battery be replaced?

If the refurbished phone's battery is fine, it will not be replaced and when you buy the phone it will use the battery that was installed by the manufacturer. If the phone is older, you might notice that it is slightly lower than 100 in Battery Health. As long as the battery health rating is in the high-90s, you're good to go.

Once again, pristine iPhones will either have a pristine battery, or a brand-new OEM or grade-A battery. In cases where the Samsung phone battery needs to be changed, OEM batteries are the best replacement to have a new battery in a refurbished phone that offers the exact same performance of the battery that the phone had in its brand-new condition as OEM parts are made by the phone's own manufacturer.
