How long is a car battery warranty?

Most manufacturers offer a warranty of around 36 months as standard. Some high-performance batteries may provide warranties extending to 60 months or more. Car battery warranties often vary based on the type of battery. For instance, traditional lead-acid batteries usually come with a warranty of three years.

Do extended warranties cover car batteries?

Other lithium batteries in Hybrid cars have 10+ years normal life expectancy. I have read where Tesla designs the battery for 15 years. In the US the warranty for the battery is 8 years and I think 10 year in California. I don't think we have pricing yet for a replacement battery on a Polestar 2 since it's still too new but I'd say it's probably around \$20k+. Lithium is greatly jumping in price due to the rarity of the mineral and the EV/power storage push.

So the battery is less than three years old, so the original battery was replaced about two years or so after the car was sold. ... 4 years or 50K miles whichever occurs first.
