Where can I find replacement parts for an electric hair clipper?

Replacement parts for an electric hair clipper or beard trimmer are available through retail stores or online from the manufacturer or aftermarket suppliers. Basic repair tools include these: You can find replacement-part kits for popular brands and models of hair clippers and beard trimmers at large retail chains.

What is an electric hair clipper?

Commonly referred to as hair clippers or a hair trimmer, an electric hair clipper is a small motorized appliance that moves cutting blades across stationary blades to cut hair. An electric beard trimmer operates in the same way, except the motor and blades typically are smaller. An electric dog grooming clipper also operates similarly.

How do you charge a clipper?

What if a hair clipper doesn't work?

If a hair clipper doesn't work at all, make sure power is on at the electrical receptacle, check the battery and recharge it if it is low or check the electrical cord. Unplug the unit, turn it over and manually move the blades. If necessary, test the motor and switches.

How do you replace the battery in a hair Trimmer?

Luckily, it is also very easy to replace the battery in a hair trimmer. Remove the door to the casing outside the battery housing. Some doors are held in place with a screw, so unscrew it before trying to pry it open. Remove the old battery (or batteries) and dispose of it properly.

How do I replace the battery on my Wahl Clipper/ Trimmer?

For battery replacement the entire, intact clipper/ trimmer should be sent to: Wahl (UK) Ltd Customer Services (the address can be found on the reverse of this booklet) or taken to a suitably qualified professional. The battery should only be replaced by the original manufacturers spare.

clipper is switched OFF when charging. During charging, the indicator light will pulse until the battery is fully charged. The charge light will be fully lit when the battery is fully charged and also during use. During use if the charge light is flashing this indicates the battery has approximately 20% charge remaining.

Take note of how the battery was oriented in the compartment: The "positive" polarity end of the battery should be inserted first according to the manufacturer's directions. Remove the new battery from its packaging and place it in the battery compartment, positioning it the same way as the previous battery.
