

How to reinstall the system when the battery crashes

How do I fix a battery not working on Windows 10?

Open the Device Manager. Expand the Batteries branch. Right-click on the Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery driver. Select Disable device. Restart your computer and then open the Device Manager. Now, right-click on the same driver and select Enable device. Now, connect the charger and see what happens.

How do I reinstall Windows 11?

Please refer to the appropriate operating instructions based on the current version of your Windows operating system on your device: Windows 11 operating system Type and search [Reset this PC] in the Windows search bar(1), then click [Open](2). Click [Reset PC](3) in Reset this PC field. Select [Remove everything](4). Select [Local reinstall](5).

How do I reinstall Windows?

Select [Local reinstall](7). If you cannot reinstall Windows via Local reinstall or any errors occurred, you are able to choose Cloud download to reinstall Windows. (Your device needs to be in an available internet environment for Cloud download.) Select [Reset](8) to start reinstalling Windows.

The reinstall will take you to the Windows Update page in Settings. It will start downloading a repair version of the last operating system update that was successfully installed on your PC. Once the download is complete, the repair version of the update installs
