

How to remove 80% battery limit Windows 10?

What is the battery limit option?

The Battery Limit option is a Unified Extensible Firmware Interface(UEFI) setting that changes how the Surface device battery is charged and might prolong its longevity. This firmware setting (similar to BIOS) is recommended for devices intended to be always connected to power.
