

Installing solar panels on the roof is not allowed in China

Are solar panels allowed on a roof?

Depending on the roof mounting system used to attach the panels, there may be 'exclusion zones' where no solar panels are allowed. These zones exist because winds are strongest around the edges of roofs. Installing away from the roof edge reduces wind loading on the panels and makes them less likely to be damaged or even torn off in a storm.

What percentage of rooftops should be solar-powered?

The state entity wants selected counties to have at least 20% of all residential rooftops equipped with solar, as well as at least 30% of commercial and industrial structures; 40% of non-government public buildings, such as hospital and schools; and half of the roofs on the government estate.
