Solar provided more power than coal did to EU countries for the first time last year, marking a new milestone in the unstoppable rise of renewables. The sunlight-soaking renewable generated 11 per cent of EU electricity in 2024, overtaking the dirtiest fossil fuel, which dropped below 10 per cent.

Why is OECD using coal so much?

The rapid growth of wind and solar power is responsible for 87 per cent of the fall in coal power in these countries during this time period, Ember says.
