

What is solar together?

Solar Together is simply a group-buying scheme that lowers the cost of purchasing solar panels -- you'll still fully own the system. The scheme isn't the same as the Rent-a-Roof initiative, which leases the entirety or part of your roof to energy companies so they can profit from any excess electricity generated by the solar panels.

How does solar together work?

It brings together residents and local councils to negotiate discounted rates by bulk purchasing. Solar Together makes it easier for people to get solar installations without breaking the bank, so more communities can go green. In some cases, the scheme has managed to secure prices that are 30-35% less than the standard market rate.

How does the solar together group-buying scheme work?

How does it work? Who can participate? All residents living in one of the participating council areas and who own their own house (or have permission from the landlord to install a solar PV system) can register for the Solar Together group-buying scheme.
