Why is my laptop battery not charging?

If your laptop has a removable battery, try reassembling it. Skip this step if the battery is non-removable. If the device/battery has not been charged for a while, connect it to power and leave it charging overnight. This may help revive the battery. If the issue persists after the above checks, proceed to the next troubleshooting step.

Why is my battery not charging with the AC adapter connected?

When the battery capacity remains around 94% to 97%, the battery will not charge with the AC adapter connected. You can unplug and re-connect the AC adapter several times to resume charging to 100%. If you experience the problem which is The battery stop being charged after the battery level is charged to 60% or 80%.

Why is my battery not charging to full?

Battery not charging to full If you experience the problem which is The battery doesn't be charged when power level is above 95% with AC adapter connected. This is a normal condition for battery protection, not a problem for either the battery itself or the charging function. When the battery is charged to 100%, it will stop being charged.

What happens if battery capacity drops with AC adapter connected?

When the battery capacity drops from 100% to 99%~95% with AC adapter connected, the battery will not be charged until the power level drops lower than 95%. When the battery capacity remains around 94% to 97%, the battery will not charge with the AC adapter connected.

What happens if AC power adapter fails?

Does ASUS use a lithium ion battery?

ASUS battery of devices utilize Li-ion battery which has no battery memory effect, and the system is able to prevent over-charge/excessive discharge/charge temperature control. One thing to be emphasized is that Li-ion battery will 'self-discharge' and battery level will slightly go down even though it is not used.

The power light indicator on or near the power button might turn on briefly but then go out. Reconnect the power cord and turn on the power. If the computer does not shut down when connected to AC adapter then, this could be an issue with the battery. Try updating the BIOS and chipset drivers on your PC using HP support assistant.

If your battery isn't fully charging, the first thing you can try is the Battery troubleshooter in Windows 10. Open Start > Settings > Update & security > Troubleshoot

I suggest using the HP PC Hardware Diagnostics UEFI utility to check the battery, power adapter and the System board. Power on and immediately tap the Esc key. In the menu that appears click on and choose the F2 key to invoke the Diagnostics. When you plug in the power adapter does the power LED light up? What color is it?

I have an HP ENVY and it keeps shutting down claiming the battery power is low. The internal battery is not charging. I am trying to use the power cable only and the laptop doesn't seem to care that it has full power. The power cable is fine. I do not care about the battery. I am buying a newer HP ...

I have a new computer (purchased in December) and suddenly, the power cord symbol is not showing when it is plugged in (regardless of outlet) nor is the battery symbol getting "full". All of the connections (in the cord and into the laptop) seem to be "tight".

My laptop also does not recognize my power cord. However, when I turn it off and leave it plugged in, the battery is full when I turn it back on after a few hours. But when the laptop is on and plugged in, it looks as if it is not plugged in and functions of the battery.

So there's two kinds of rechargeable batteries you can buy for the Series controllers. There's the 3rd party play and charge kits where the batteries have a built in micro-usb port, but they won't charge via usb-c thru the controller.

The laptop uses ac adaptor when plugged in. Not battery. If you take a look at the battery icon when plugged in, you would see it goes to 100, then gets discharged to some level and charging back again. So the simple answer is that laptop does not use power from battery when plugged in. Battery gets charged and discharged. Does this kill battery?

If the power cord or AC adaptor is plugged into a surge protector, verify that the surge protector is powered on. Reset internal battery. Try a power reset.
