Does Windows 11 24h2 affect battery life?

After updating to the Windows 11 24H2 version,I am experiencing significant battery-related issues on my device. This Include Faster Battery Drain: I have noticed a substantially reduced battery lifecompared to the performance before the update. Even during minimal usage,the battery percentage drops quickly.

Does Windows 11 have a bad battery life?

The battery report generated shows that the maximum recorded time was just a little over 4 hours. Even when

the computer is at 100% charge, it always estimates that the remaining battery time is 2h 33m. This is too low. I haven't been able to go half of a workday so far without my laptop dying, and I'm getting concerned.

Charge your laptop to 100%. Disconnect the charger and use your laptop until the battery drains completely and the laptop shuts down. Leave your laptop off for at least 5 ...

Settings >> System >> Troubleshoot >> Other troubleshooter >> Look for power and select Run. Generate Battery report to check battery health. Open Command prompt and run as administrator >> Click on Yes when a UAC prompt appears on the screen >> type the following command below and press Enter to generate battery report.

After resuming and logging in to Windows, I could see for maybe 2 seconds that the system has been super fast ('regular' fast) on battery, not being throttled: After 2 seconds it was back to the 10 W limit. Feels like ...

And the problem is that when I am on battery its very very very slow, I did set it up on high performance it was a little better but still very slow. there is no system resources usage above 30, 40, 50 max % on the ram cpu or disk. But, when i plug in my power supply sudenly the laptop becomes rocket fast very very fast as it should be.
